



Vocabulary marking stickers

Of the many compelling reasons for actively and systematically teaching vocabulary, none is more important than the contribution of word knowledge to reading comprehension. Indeed, one of the most enduring findings in reading research is the extent to which students' vocabulary knowledge relates to their reading comprehension (e.g. Anderson & Freebody, 1981; Baumann, Kame'enui, & Ash, 2003; Becker, 1977; Davis, 1942; Whipple, 1925). Given that success in school and beyond depends in great measure upon the ability to read with comprehension, there is an urgency to providing instruction that equips children with the skills and strategies necessary for lifelong vocabulary development.
